## Risk Factors (cont.) Fetal abnormality or other medical indications for the abortion Commitment or attachment to the pregnancy Advanced stage of pregnancy Putting great effort into keeping the abortion a secret for fear of stigma Usual coping style is denial and repressing thoughts Unresolved past losses and perception of abortion as a loss Past or present sexual, physical, or emotional abuse Preexisting experience of trauma Expecting depression, severe grief or guilt, and regret after the abortion Disbelief in their ability to do what it takes to produce a positive outcome

## Preabortion "Counseling" Context: often group counseling not individual Time limitation: 5 – 10 minutes No pre-procedure meeting with provider Misinformed consent Misinformation re fetal development & uterine contents, alternatives, risks & benefits Nonprofessional counselor doing "counseling" Significant conflicts of interests - \$ beforehand Discouragement of alternatives Encouraged to act immediately Decision facilitation v. decision exploration
